20 (EM) Well, Jim, Jack said otherwise.

21 (Long pause)

22 Q(Boyd) Do you have a question?

23 Q(EM) Is there any reason, that you can think of that would cause me to  
24 make a phone call to my employer and say that I will not be into work?

25 A(Miles) I have no knowledge

26 Q(EM) Nothing you said or did would scare somebody?

27 A(Miles) Mr Miller – I have, to the best of my recollections, I had no contact  
28 with you prior to that hearing. I HAVE NO KNOWLEDGE about any part of that  
29 suit that you had, before that. The first time I ever had any contact with you was  
30 the day that you had set your belongings on fire in your driveway.

31 Q(EM) And you know I HAVE A TAPE OF YOU right?

32 A(Miles) I know you turned on a tape recorder when I relayed the message; I
