1 (EM) But if you're relaying messages that came from the County

4 A (miles) The second time I already told you the purposes that I came

12 would be upset if, if the property that he was going to have a sheriff sale  
13 with—was being destroyed in my own front yard?

14 (Boyd) Object to the form of the question. That assumes that the  
15 Sheriff was going to have a Sheriff's sale and there is no evidence of that  
16 in the record anywhere.

17 (EM) **Well you need to talk to Tom Dyer then, because he threaten  
18 me with a Sheriff sale if I didn't settle the matter before my civil case.**

19 (Miles) Mr. Miller, you told me

20 (EM) Yeh, I know – I'm telling you what Mr. Tom Dyer threaten  
21 me before my civil case.

22 (Miles) I can understand, I have no knowledge of any of that stuff.
